#### **EVINCO**

The event was organised by the Cultural Committee, headed by Shivani Banpurkar and Anurag Mali.

The event took place on 4th February and 5th February 2023.

The auction for the football and cricket tournament took place on the **26**th **of January, 2023** which was organised by the cultural committee of NLDIMSR with the guidance of our committee head Shivani Banpurkar. The owners were invited to the event who bid on players in the auction. It was made sure that the owners are aware and clear about all the rules and regulations for the auction, such as the budget for each team, the number of players to be bought by each team, and the order of the auction. Every team of cricket was given 90 lakhs each and football teams where allotted 50 lakhs each to bid for players. The **auctioneer** for cricket and football event were **Preyash Gada** and **Akshat Sisodia** respectively. The biding process started by calling out the first player's name with his picture and details displayed on the screen. The owners continued to bid on the player until the highest bid was reached. There were in total 10 teams of boys and 3 teams of girls in cricket and 6 teams of boys in football. The bidding process continued until all players were bought or the allotted budget for each team has been exhausted. It was ensured that the cricket and football auction was conducted fairly and efficiently.

#### **FOOTBALL**

The Football tournament was held on 4th February 2023, at The Hitman Turf, Mira Road (West).

The event began at 3:30 pm. A total of 6 teams participated which were North-East United, Mumbai City FC, Goa FC, Bangalore FC, ATK, Kerela Blasters.


