on Scholarships for PGDM Batch 2022-24 Students



An analysis has been done of 300 students (180 PGDM & 120 PGDM (Finance)) for considering the academically exceptional students for scholarship for their First Year at N. L. Dalmia Institute of Management Studies and Research for A. Y. 2022-23

Criteria for Scholarship for First Year students have been as follows

- Have been 'Admitted' to the PGDM/PGDM (Fin) program
- Is in the Top 10 students in the Final Admission List of 300 students
- Students having fulfilled criteria 1 & 2 and having the following CAT/XAT/CMAT/MH-CET percentiles will have the respective percentage of Scholarships offered for First Year PGDM/PGDM (Fin)
